

Lesson Policy

Lesson Types & Payment

Students may purchase and schedule lessons by the hour, half-hour, or by bundle. Each lesson bundle comes at a 10% discount and includes a free monthly goals consultation and inclusion in the quarterly student showcase.

Individual lessons are offered on a first-come, first-served availability, and can be scheduled through the Improving Arts Academy website.

Lesson bundles include four credits students may use to schedule lessons within a forty-five day period. Students will receive their individualized lesson code via email to redeem at the Improving Arts Academy website. Students are responsible for using lesson credits to schedule lessons based on instructor availability. If lesson credits are not used within the forty-five (45) day limit, credits expire and cannot be refunded.

Cancellation Policy
